- Who can participate?: City of Winnsboro residents inside the city limits, no businesses please! A copy of your water bill and driver's license are required to prove residency. Someone will be present to monitor each vehicle.
- Do I have to unload my vehicle? We will have volunteers on hand to help you unload your vehicle.
- Are there fees to participate? NO! The City is hosting this for free as part of our commitment to the Community.
- <u>Is there a pick up service?</u> Yes, for disabled and elderly citizens. Please contact City Hall at 903.342.3654 to request this service as soon as possible and prior to noon on Friday 04/21/17. Items must be placed curbside and volunteers will not pick up items that are too heavy to lift. LIMITED SERVICES SO BE SURE TO CALL!
- Are there loads or materials you won't accept? Yes, we have the right to refuse loads or unacceptable materials.
   Large brush must be taken to the City's Brush Dump. (515 E. to CR 4400, left on CR 4403, drive at the end of road.)
